LEAGUE AGE: The date for determining League Age of a player is April 30, 2010.

TRY-OUTS: All children who will be ages 9 through 12 on or before April 30, 2010 must try-out. Try-outs are scheduled for Dec. 5 & 6, 2009 with a make up on Dec. 8th at La Paz Sports Park. Kids who will be 8 on or before April 30, 2010 are encouraged to attend try-outs for the AA draft. Children cannot play in the AA Division without attending try-outs.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION: All players must show 3 forms of proof of residence. Returning players are eligible to play in RNLL, even if they have relocated, with an approved waiver. All new players must also show a birth certificate. All waived players no longer residing within RNLL Boundaries must have waivers verified.

BOUNDARIES: New players must reside within the Rancho Niguel boundaries of Laguna Niguel. This includes all addresses north and west of the following line: Crown Valley Parkway north to Adelanto Drive, east to Golden Lantern, north to Paseo de Colinas and east to Camino Capistrano. See the RNLL web site for a detailed map.

VOLUNTEER SERVICE: RNLL is staffed 100% by volunteers. Every family is required to contribute time to assure a positive experience for our kids. Please download a form from the web site and sign up as a manager, coach, umpire, sponsor or snack bar staff.

LATE FEE / REFUNDS: Any registration after November 7, 2009 will be assessed a \$25.00 late fee. No refunds will be given after the 2010 draft. An additional \$25 fee will be charged for returned checks.

You are required to register online in advance.

2010 Spring Registration Steps

1. Before coming to sign-ups, go to www.rnllbaseball.org and click on "Online Registration"
2. Complete the registration form online. A completed registration form (pdf) will be emailed to you within 2 days. Print, sign and bring the form to the walk in portion of the registration at Crown Valley Elementary on Friday, October, 23rd from 6:30 – 9:30pm or Saturday, November 7th from 2:00 – 5:00pm.
3. Bring three (3) forms of proof of residency (utility bill, mortgage statement, property tax statement, etc.) and a copy of your driver license (for parent volunteers). New players need to bring an original birth certificate for age verification.
4. Bring a check made out to RNLL for the appropriate registrations fees.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. *I registered online, do I still have to come in on Oct 23rd or Nov 7th?*
YES. We must confirm your residence in our boundary via utility bill, check birth certificate (new players only), confirm payment, and sign-up for volunteer position.
2. *Do I have to print my registration form and bring it to sign-ups?*
YES. But if you don't have access to a printer you can still register in person on the sign-up dates.
3. *If I am new to the area, how do I know if I live in the Rancho Niguel Little League boundary or the Laguna Niguel Little League boundary?*
You can check the league boundary maps located on the leagues websites www.rnllbaseball.org and www.lnll.org

In general, all residents of Laguna Niguel who live north and west of the following line, are eligible to register with RNLL: Crown Valley Parkway, beginning at the south city boundary at the intersection with Pacific Island Drive (Camino del Avion), north to Adelanto Drive. Adelanto Drive east to the intersection with Golden Lantern. Golden Lantern north to the intersection with Paseo De Colinas. Paseo De Colinas east and north to the city boundary at Camino Capistrano.
